LLMC Digital offers researchers enhanced search functionality by identifying important pages to enhance user navigation. Below is the list of Page Types searchable on LLMC Digital. NOTE: not all Page Types will apply to all content.

- <u>Agency Table</u> identified as "Agency Table" within the book.
- <u>Annex</u> identified as "Annex" within the book. Page contains appended or additional information for the document.
- Appendix identified as "Appendix" within the book. Page contains additional information for the book.
- **<u>Bibliography</u>** identified as "Bibliography" within the book and labeled as such.
- <u>Chapter</u> identified as "Chapter" within the book and labeled as such. The main division of a book.
- <u>Charts/Diagrams/Graphs</u> page contains a chart, diagram or graph.
- **Citation Page** includes a list of sources associated with this volume.
- <u>Digest</u> identified as "Digest" within the book. Page contains a compilation of legal rules, statutes, or decisions.
- Errata identified as "Errata" within the book. Page indicates printer error(s) within the publication.
- Foreword identified as "Foreword" within the book. Page contains a short introduction to the book.
- <u>Glossary</u> identified as "Glossary" within the book. A list of terms or words found within the book which includes the definition and the location within the text.
- <u>History</u> identified as "History" within the book. Legislative history is a legal term used to describe any materials created during the process of making a legislative bill.
- Illustration/Pictures page contains an illustration or picture.
- <u>Index</u> identified as "Index" within the book. This page will list reference information which can be found in the book.
- Manuscript page contains handwritten material.
- Maps page contains a map.
- **Notes** identified as "Note" within the book. Statements that were written for the reader to clarify the text material.
- Order identified as "Order" within the book. Instructions issued by the judge or the court of law.
- <u>Preface</u> identified as "Preface" within the book. This page contains introductory or preliminary information.
- **Regulations** identified as "Regulations". An official rule, law, or order stating what may or may not be done or how something must be done.
- Rules identified as "Rules". This page contains information regarding the following items: an order or a direction made in court, regulating court practices or action of parties, and the house rules and the joint rules in the Senate.
- <u>Supplement</u> identified as "Supplement". This page contains supplementary information for the title or book.
- <u>Table</u> page contains a table (a set of facts or figures systematically displayed).
- Table of Contents identified as "Table of Contents" within the book.
